2026 Annual Appeal and Helen Wheeler Scholarship Fund

In 1954, Katharine Bailey Mann founded Berrybrook School on over 60 acres of land that was once called “Molkiah Farm” on Winter Street in Duxbury. Mrs. Mann’s dream was “to provide a place to develop self esteem and confidence, to help a child not to be afraid to fail – to learn by trying.” She wanted children to have the opportunity to explore and create, to learn from hands on experience, to learn to handle feelings and to accept them, to search out beauty in the world around them, to delight in exercising their bodies and to find out what they can do; a program that gives children time to develop their own ideas and to find their own answers. Berrybrook has provided over seventy years of fulfilling Mrs. Mann’s dream.

Mrs. Mann also had the foresight to create The Helen Wheeler Scholarship Fund. This Fund’s primary purpose is to provide tuition assistance to parents and/or guardians of children who have been accepted to Berrybrook, and who would not be able to attend without financial assistance. All money raised through the Berrybrook Annual Appeal is earmarked for the Wheeler Fund.
